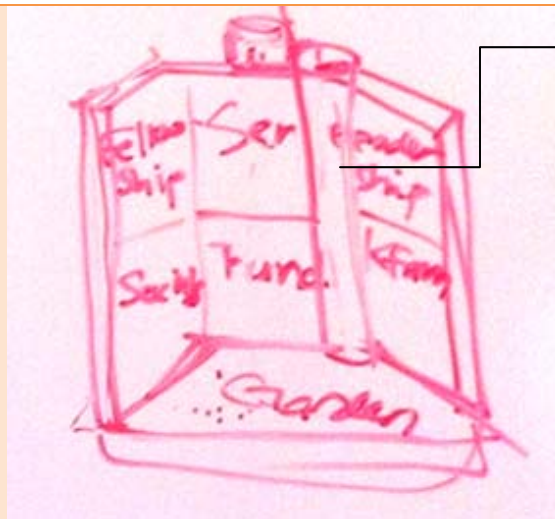


(Left) UCSD's 2010-2011 Scrapbook workday. Our theme was Wizard of Oz so we made Dorothy's house, golden road, and rainbow.

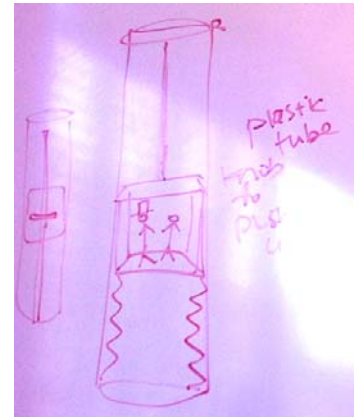


(Above) UC Berkeley's 2009-2010 Scrapbook.
